

Allah's Messenger صلى الله عليه وسلم said: "The best of you is he who learns the Qur'an and teaches it to others." (Al-Bukhari)



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
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

On the authority of Ka`b bin `Ujrah (radiAllaahu anhu) that the Messenger of Allaah صلى الله عليه وسلم said :

"There are some words, the reciters of which will never be disappointed. These are: Tasbih [saying `Subhan-Allah' (Allah is free from imperfection)], thirty-three times, Tahmid [saying `Alhamdu lillah' (praise be to Allah)] thirty-three times and Takbir [saying `Allahu Akbar' (Allah is Greatest)] thirty-four times; and these should be recited after the conclusion of every prescribed prayer."

On the authority of Abu Hurairah (radiAllaahu anhu) that the Messenger of Allaah صلى الله عليه وسلم said :

Let him who believes in Allah and the Last Day speak good, or keep silent; and let him who believes in Allah and the Last Day be generous to his neighbour; and let him who believes in Allah and the Last Day be generous to his guest.

It was related by al-Bukhari and Muslim.

The Messenger of Allaah (sallAllaahu alayhi wa sallam) said :

Do not envy one another, and do not inflate prices for one another, and do not hate one another, and do not turn away from one another, and do not undercut one another in trade, but [rather] be Slaves of Allah and Brothers [amongst yourselves]. A Muslim is the brother of a Muslim: he does not oppress him, nor does he fail him, nor does he lie to him, nor does he hold him in contempt. Taqwaa (Piety) is right here [and he pointed to his chest three times]. It is evil enough for a man to hold his brother Muslim in contempt. The whole of a Muslim is inviolable for another Muslim: his blood, his property, and his honour.

That a man said to the Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم: "Counsel me", so he صلى الله عليه said :

Do not become angry.

The man repeated [his request for counsel] several times, and he صلى الله عليه وسلم said:

Do not become angry.

It was related by al-Bukhaaree and Muslim.
